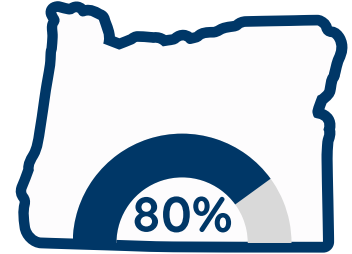
OREGON TECH'S MISSION

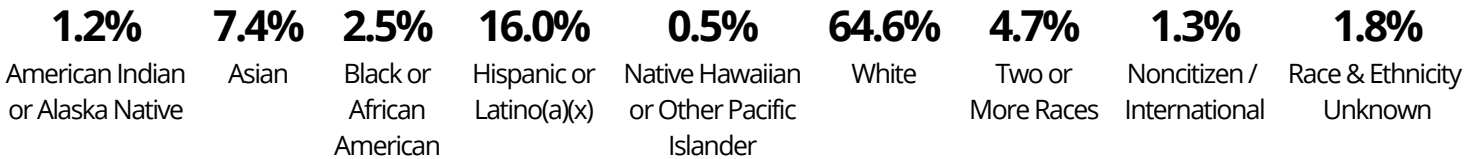

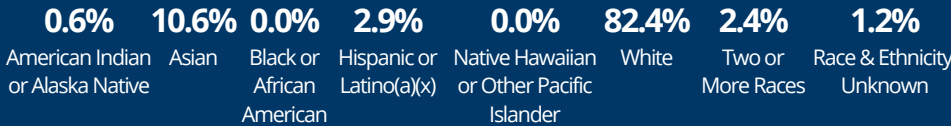

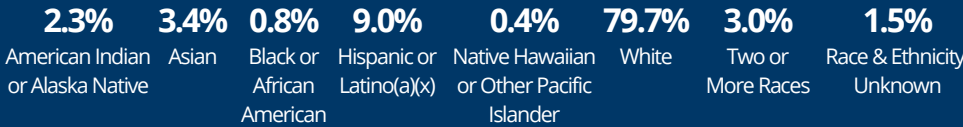

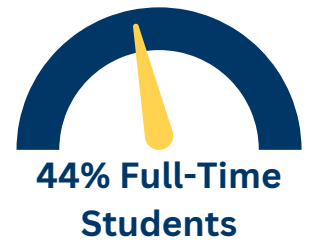

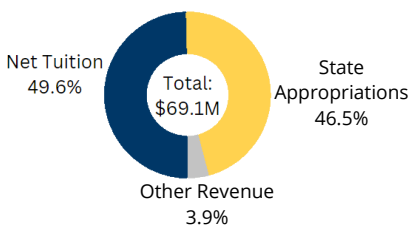


63% Degree-Seeking Undergraduate Students

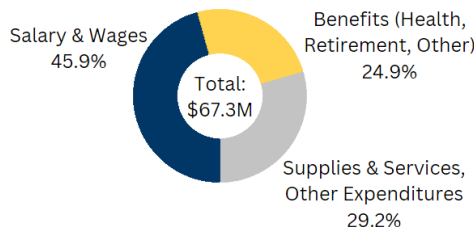


44% Full-Time Students
