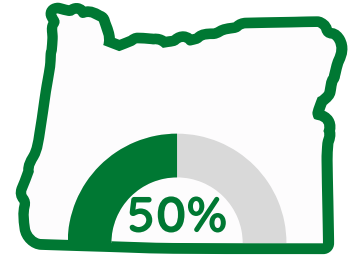
UO'S MISSION

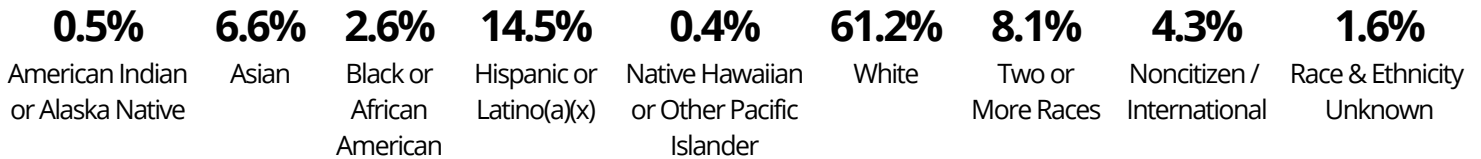


23,202 students enrolled

Resident Students

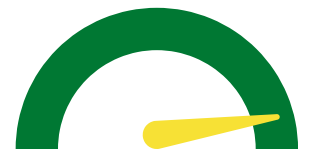

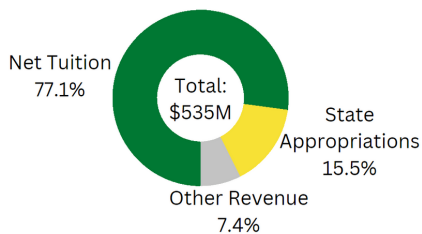

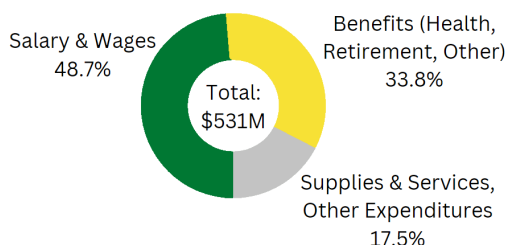
